Release of Liability

I acknowledge I have voluntarily applied to participate and use, with or without my dog(s), at the Dyersville Family Aquatic Center for the Puppy Paddle/Doggy Dip. I understand the act of unleashing my dog(s) and being physically present inside the pool area necessarily involves risks of injury to me, other people, my dog(s), and other dogs. I understand these risks are entirely my responsibility. I expressly assume these risks. I am aware of the risks and hazards inherent upon entering the pool area and I choose to voluntarily enter the premises, knowing the conditions might become more hazardous and/or dangerous for myself and/or dog(s). I voluntarily assume all such risks, losses, damages, or injuries that may be sustained by entering the pool.

By signing this release of liability and using the pool during the Puppy Paddle/Doggy Dip, I hereby fully and forever release, indemnify, and discharge the City of Dyersville, the City of Dyersville Parks and Recreation Department, the Dyersville Family Aquatic Center and their volunteers, vendors, employees, and agents from any claims, demands, damages, rights of action or causes of action, present or future, whether the same be known or unknown, anticipated or unanticipated, resulting from or arising out of my use or intended use of the pool. I fully and forever release and discharge the City of Dyersville, the Dyersville Parks and Recreation Department, the Dyersville Family Aquatic Center and their volunteers, vendors, employees and agents from any and all negligent acts and omissions in the same.

I also grant permission to these organizations to use pictures or videos taken of me, my family, and/or my dog(s) during participation in this event. I understand these images may be used for promotional, news, research, and/or educational purposes, including on the Internet. I understand that images posted on the internet can be downloaded by any computer user. I waive my right to inspection or compensation.

Rules and Regulations:

- Each dog must be accompanied by one handler who is at least 16 years of age.
 - One handler per dog is allowed in the water (at their own risk) ONLY to assist dog with exit/entry.
 - Humans may enter the water only to their knees. Heads must stay above water at all times.
- For your safety, humans under the age of 10 are not permitted at this event.
- All patrons entering the facility will need to sign a release waiver.
- Handlers must show current rabies and distemper vaccination records for each dog upon entry.
 - **Rabies tags will NOT suffice.** Each dog **must** have vet records with them at their time of entry.
- Dogs must be at least 16 weeks (4 months) of age and in good health to participate in this event. Female dogs in heat are not allowed.
- Dogs must enter and exit the aquatic facility on a leash and wear a collar for the duration of the swim.
 - Spike and electric collars are not allowed.
- Handlers are responsible for keeping their dogs in the Aquatic Center.
- Handlers are responsible for immediately cleaning up after their dog.
 - Bags and trash cans will be available
- Dogs and humans are not allowed on slides, diving boards, chairs, or any other play structures.
- SOFT dog toys are allowed
- Event organizers and management have the right to remove any dog & owner without refund.
- Lifeguards will be on duty to assist humans only, NOT to rescue dogs. If a dog begins to drown, their human is responsible for saving them.
- No food consumption by humans or dogs is allowed. Water will be provided for dogs.
- Special restrictions:
 - 6-6:45 PM--Dogs 40 pounds and below
 - 7-7:45 PM-- Dogs 41 pounds and above
- Disclaimer: There will be appropriate levels of pool chemicals (chlorine, acid, etc.) in the water.
 - Circulation pumps will remain on and active during the swim to filter the water
