Item #1: Town Square/Downtown Market

Goldsmith had questions as to the impact of the sidewalk installation and amphitheater installation to the Downtown Market. It was questioned what dates the installation would take place. Nadermann had no dates at this time and would need to check with the City Administrator as to the time frame of these installations. The first market date is set for June 26, 2021. They plan to have over 70 vendors and will be dispersing coupons for stores in town to get people to spend locally. They also plan to have food trucks as well.

Item #2: Indoor Complex

Goldsmith also discussed how Monticello has an indoor complex and thought it would be a nice feature for the City of Dyersville. Nadermann thought it would be good to get it on the city’s radar. They thought Champion Homes would have been a great place for this type of facilities; however, it was recently purchased. Ideas for items in the facility are: batting cages, indoor soccer, baseball, rock walls, etc. They are aware that the cost would determine the type of funding available. Goldsmith suggested it to the Imagine 2030 board as well.

Commission Oral Comments:

Huehnergath suggested we have pickleball courts somewhere in addition to the ones on the tennis courts. He stated that it is very popular right now. It was questioned whether these could be placed down by Westside Park.

There were questions as to what is taking place with the bathrooms at Candy Cane park. It was previously decided that these bathrooms would be removed and new ones established. Due to the time constraints with Baseball Factory tournaments, we were not able to do as originally planned. We will be keeping them this year and doing some minor enhancements. We will not be opening the concession stand at Candy Cane. Roman plans to have food trucks for these events. Kluesner said for their tournament this weekend, they would be having a makeshift concession stand.

City residents have asked about water fountains down by the trail at Westside and maybe the dog park. This will be addressed in the future.

Klostermann asked about the pool canopy. Nadermann stated that Out Run the Rays has funding, but no action has been taken at this time.
