124.01 PERMIT REQUIRED. No person shall do work in the City as an electrician or electrical contractor without an annual permit issued by the City. The fee for such permit is set by resolution of the Council. Applicants shall file in the office of the Clerk an application in writing, giving the name and place of business of the applicant and stating a willingness to be governed in all respects by the rules and regulations of the City. Other than as provided in Section 124.06, permits may be issued only to individual natural persons and may not be issued to partnerships, firms or corporations.

124.02 EXEMPTIONS. The provisions of this chapter do not apply to regular employees of manufacturing or industrial concerns or public utilities or railroads when said employees are performing electrical work for their employers.

124.03 BOND. Application for a permit shall be accompanied by a bond with two or more sureties or a corporate surety to be approved by the City in the penal sum of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00), conditioned that the applicant will indemnify and keep harmless the City from all liability for any accidents or damages, claims, judgments, costs or expenses caused by any negligence or unskillfulness or from any unfaithful or inadequate work done under such permit.

124.04 INSURANCE. The applicant shall also file a certificate of insurance indicating that the applicant is carrying liability coverage in an amount not less than \$100,000 per person, \$300,000 per occurrence. The certificate of insurance shall provide for ten (10) days written notice of cancellation to the City.

124.05 ISSUANCE. Upon the acceptance of the application, filing of bond and insurance certificate and the payment of the fee by the applicant, the City shall issue an annual permit to the individual making application.

124.06 GROUP PERMIT. Partnerships, firms, or corporations employing more than 35 electricians may apply for a group permit. The application for a group permit shall be accompanied by a bond with two or more sureties or a corporate surety to be approved by the City in the penal sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00), conditioned that the applicant will indemnify and keep harmless the City from all liability for any accidents or damages, claims, judgments, costs or expenses caused by any negligence or unskillfulness or from an unfaithful or inadequate work done under such permit. The applicant shall also file a certificate of insurance indicating that the applicant is carrying liability coverage in an amount not less than \$300,000.00 per person and \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence. The certificate of insurance shall provide for ten (10) days written notice of cancellation to the City. Upon the acceptance of the application, filing of bond and insurance certificate and the payment of the fee to be established by resolution of the Council, the City shall issue an annual permit to the partnership, firm or corporation making the application.
