You are invited to attend a public information meeting for the upcoming improvements to the intersection of X-49 (332nd Street) and 1st Avenue west (D22) in the City of Dyersville. The City has secured \$264,000 in Federal funding for a project for improvements to the intersection. Intersection improvements will consider several intersection configurations including modifications to the existing four way stop, realignment to provide better intersection truck turning movements and allow future signalization, and a roundabout.

The meeting will take place at the Dyersville City Council Chamber on May 16, 2016 following the regularly scheduled City council meeting (estimated start time of 8:00 P.M.), exhibits about the project will be available for review. Representatives of the City of Dyersville and engineering consultant, IIW, P.C., will be available to discuss the proposed project and listen to any questions.

We want to have a discussion about what characteristics will comprise the best project for the intersection considering safety and function. With the interchange at Highway 20 currently under construction, it is anticipated this intersection will be one of the gateways into Dyersville from the west side. The goal of the meeting is also to identify any considerations that would preclude considering a design option. The construction is anticipated to occur in fall of 2017. At the meeting we want to hear your thoughts and any concerns.
