A League Softball Rules 2017

Game Information

- 1. Games need to start on time.
- 2. Please have your team ready 15 minutes prior to the scheduled start time in case you can get started early to help keep games on time.
- 3. No new inning will start after 1 hour and 20 minutes. In case of a tie, the international tie breaker rule will be used by starting a runner that made last out on second base.
- 4. If you are playing the last game of the night, you may play all innings if decided between both coaches BEFORE the game starts.
- 5. If you need an extra player, you may borrow a "B" League player from our league.
- 6. 12 run rule after 4 innings and 10 run rule after 5 innings.
- 7. Dugout is to be picked up after you are done playing.
- 8. Home plate umpire can request a base umpire, to be supplied by the home team.
- 9. No hitting into fences allowed at any time, which includes the hanging of a tarp with any type of ball.
- 10. ALL UMPIRE DECISIONS ARE FINAL! NO PROTESTS!

Equipment

- 11. All bases are at 60 feet apart. Safety bases will be used.
- 12. Batting helmets are mandatory, face guards and chin straps are recommended.
- 13. No baseball bats allowed.
- 14. Pants or Shorts may be worn.
- 15. No steel/metal spikes allowed.
- 16. Optic SB 12 yellow softball will be used.

Fielding

- 17. 8 players are required to start a game. Teams can play 10 or 9 players, but NO infield rover.
- 18. Infield fly rule will be used.
- 19. If a catcher is on base with 2 outs, she should be substituted by the player who made the last out to help games from slowing down.

Pitching

- 20. New pitchers will get 5 warm up pitches to start the game and 5 warm up pitches between innings.
- 21. If a pitcher pitches for her varsity high school team, she is NOT allowed to pitch in league.
- 22. Pitchers motion must start with both feet contacting the rubber which is 43 feet from home plate.
- 23. If pitched ball hits ground and then the batter, it is a dead ball and base is awarded. Player must make attempt to move out of the way.
- 24. A pitcher is limited to 4 innings per game; one pitch in an inning constitutes an inning. Once a pitcher is removed from that position, she may re-enter only once later in the game as long as she has not pitched more than 4 innings.

Batting

- 25. Bunting and stealing are allowed.
- 26. If the batter shows a bunt, she may not swing away. If the batter swings, it is an out.
- 27. Teams will bat their entire roster and no girl can sit out consecutive innings.

- 28. Must slide if being played upon.
- 29. A dropped 3rd strike will be played per Iowa High School Rules. Home plate is OPEN.
- 30. Stealing is allowed when the ball leaves the pitchers hand.

Substitution

31. If you need an extra player, you may borrow a "B" league player from our league, that player can play any position.
